All applicants interviewed will be accepted upon their true and evident desire to be set free from addiction. Approved applicants must show a willingness to participate in the Isaiah House program, and possess medical and mental stability.

The Problem

*All I need is a job, a car, and a woman," said John,*an alcoholic who had just graduated from a six month residential treatment program.*

He got the car, the job and ran off the woman. He rented a cheap studio apartment, threw his belongings on the bed and headed to the store to buy a six-pack. After popping open the seventh beer, he was pulled over and arrested by a police officer. Another DUI. Sound familiar?

The Situation:

Many men having successfully completed a substance abuse program are not ready or fully prepared to be integrated back into society or the homes they left. Many are left without viable transportation, housing, or jobs. Some lack the skills to even succeed in these areas. Without help, the propensity to slip back into substance abuse and old habits is probable. Evidence of this problem is reflected in the increased number of first time and repeat offenders in drug courts, jails and prisons.

Evidence is in the number of broken families and children now in State care or living with relatives. Evidence is in the number of drug related thefts, automobile accidents, domestic violence and disturbances of the peace.



The Solution:

Provide housing and meals at an affordable cost. Offer care, training, and counseling in all areas applicable to the recovering addict. Provide assistance in finding employment. Help secure independent housing and locate a church community. Assist with family reunification and restoration of broken relationships.

Isaiah House shall offer:

- **Continued Sobriety** – Daily Living, attend Meetings
- **Mental Health** – Positive Motivation, Stress Management, Communication Skills
- **Physical Health** – Hygiene, Fitness, Nutrition
- **Spiritual Health** – Bible Studies, 12-Step Scripture Program, One-on-one counseling
- **Money Management** – How to manage and budget money
- **Manhood** – How to be a man: What does a husband, father, neighbor look like, how to respect and court a woman.
- **Employment** – How to dress, write a resume, apply for a job, find work, and interview effectively.
- **Education** – Gain skills for work through training, educational resources, GED.
