Program Fees:

Isaiah House is a non-profit 501-c-3 organization and does not receive funding from any federal, state, court, or social service program. Operating costs are covered solely through entrance fees, residency fees, and donations.

All residency fees are due each Friday to cover the upcoming week. An entrance fee of \$500 is due on the day of admittance.

You are to be self-supporting once you enter as a full-time resident. You are not permitted to ask anyone else to pay for you, even if you get financially behind. A weekly residency fee of \$240 is due each Friday for the week ahead.

Isaiah House does not accept insurance. Payments are made in the form of cash, check, money order or cashiers check. Payments may be made by PayPal on our website but 2.75% must be added for the processing fee.

All returned checks will incur a \$35 fee to be paid by the resident in cash.
